### **Executive Summary**

This ordinance will levy a 2025 property tax of \$3,780,882 to be collected during 2026.

### **Background**

The City of Collinsville's property tax levy is increasing for the pensions only, the corporate portion is zero. The portion of property tax dedicated to police and fire pensions has increased significantly since 2007.

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance to allow Madison and St. Clair Counties to collect \$3,780,882 in property taxes from residents and businesses within the corporate boundary of the City of Collinsville during the 2026 calendar year.

### **Alternatives**

If the City of Collinsville does not adopt and file the property tax levy with the county clerks, there will be no property tax collected on behalf of the City in 2026.

### **Funding Source**

The 2025 property tax ordinance will provide revenue in 2026 to the following funds:
