### SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Every five (5) years St. Clair County EMA is required by federal law to update its All-Hazards Mitigation Plan and submit it to FEMA. One of the requirements from FEMA is for the County to establish an all-hazard committee made up of the communities in Madison County. The purpose of this committee is to provide input specific to their jurisdiction, and to participate in reviewing the “*ST. CLAIR COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN*”. St. Clair County recently completed the 2025 plan after several meetings involving Madison County Stakeholders including the City of Collinsville.

The plan evaluates damage to life and property from natural and man-made hazards in the County and identifies activities to reduce these damages. These mitigation activities are based on assessment of past natural and man-made activities that have created extensive damage.

St. Clair County EMA received FEMA notification that the plan has received “approval pending adoption”. The next step is for each entity to adopt the plan by resolution in order to be eligible for Federal funding for mitigation projects and federally declared disasters.

### Recommendation

Approve the Resolution adopting St. Clair County’s Plan.
