SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Approve a resolution authorizing the City to enter into a Local Agency Funding Agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) for the Horseshoe Lake Road and McDonough Lake Road Signalization Project.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes the City to enter into a funding agreement with IDOT for federal participation in the signalization of the intersection of Horseshoe Lake Road and McDonough Lake Road, including future maintenance of the improvements.

BACKGROUND

The City was awarded a \$518,400 grant, or 80% of the estimated total construction and construction engineering costs, for the Horseshoe Lake Road and McDonough Lake Road Signalization Project. The City's share of the remaining costs, estimated at \$129,600 or 20%, will be funded through Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) funds.

This project consists of installing a traffic signal at the intersection, along with all other necessary work to complete the project.

Execution of a funding agreement is required for the City to utilize the awarded federal funds.

This project is expected to go out to bid in June, with construction beginning in August or September.
