SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Approve ordinance authorizing the installation of two stop signs on Clay Street at its intersection with Summit Avenue.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Staff recommends that stop signs be placed on Clay Street at its intersection with Summit Avenue to help improve safety at the intersection.

BACKGROUND

The current intersection is stop controlled along Summit Avenue, with free flow traffic along Clay Street. A stop sign is being added for the following reasons:

- There are sight obstructions at the intersection that make it difficult for southbound drivers on Summit Avenue to see eastbound drivers on Clay Street.
- The traffic volumes on Clay Street and Summit Avenue are evenly distributed among the two streets.
- There have been multiple accidents at this intersection since 2021.
