Project Description

This project designs a shared use path, sidewalk and pedestrian scale lighting along Clay Street from Summit Avenue to North Seminary Street. The total cost of design is estimated to cost \$180,000 and the City has been awarded \$144,000 in CMAQ funding to cover design. The total expected design cost to the City is estimated to be around \$36,000. The City has also secured CMAQ funding for the construction and construction engineering of this project in the amount of \$1,064,000 and the project is expected to begin construction in 2028.

Existing Condition

The pedestrian and bicycle accommodations along this section of Clay Street are lacking and it does not feel like it fits with the rest of the Uptown. The sidewalks are in poor condition and the lighting is not consistent with the rest of Uptown.

Project Goals

Provide an entrance to Uptown for cyclists, make this area of Clay Street feel like part of the Uptown, and increase safety for pedestrians and bicyclists.
