SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Approve an ordinance authorizing the jurisdictional transfer of 0.03 miles of Ramada Boulevard from Illinois Department of Transportation to the City of Collinsville.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This agreement transfers 0.03 miles of Ramada Boulevard beginning at the east edge of pavement of northbound IL 157 easterly. The remaining portion of Ramada Boulevard is already under the City's jurisdiction.

BACKGROUND

The first 0.03 miles of Ramada Boulevard has historically been under Illinois Department of Transportation's (IDOT's) jurisdiction for maintenance. A change in maintenance responsibility is necessary to facilitate the improvements being made by AKG Development in this area. AKG Development is bringing in a commercial development at the intersection of IL 157 and Ramada Boulevard.

AKG's commercial development includes improvements to IL 157 and Ramada Boulevard. The developer will be adding a right turn lane to northbound IL 157. They will also be adding two lanes to Ramada, bringing the total number of west bound lanes to four, consisting of two left turn lanes, a thru lane, and a right turn lane, with a median between the east bound and west bound lanes.

Due to the improvements, IDOT is requiring the jurisdictional transfer of this small portion of Ramada Boulevard, which is an IDOT policy. This ordinance fulfills this requirement, allowing the development to move forward.
