Project Description

Project involves design and easement acquisition for the reconstruction of the roadway which includes a sidewalk, shared-use path, curb and gutter, and an enclosed storm sewer system along Summit Avenue from Notting Hill Court to Alco Drive. The total project is estimated to cost \$1,360,000 and the City has been awarded \$430,404 in STP funding and has been granted \$142,468 in funding by Madison County. The expected cost to the City is estimated to be around \$756,100.

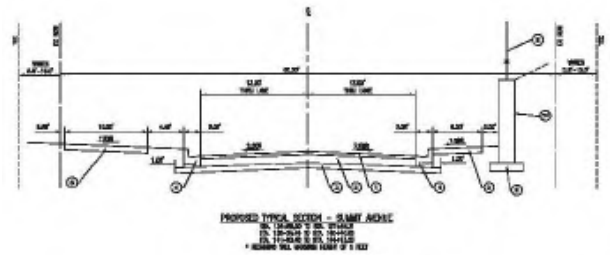
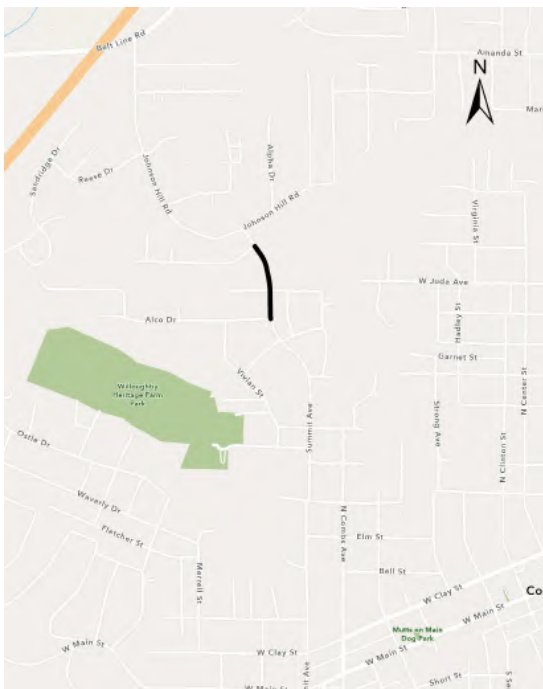
Existing Condition

The existing asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, and storm sewer system are in need of an upgrade and there are currently no sidewalks or shared-use paths along this portion of Summit Avenue.

Project Goals

Improve pavement condition, enclose the existing storm sewer system, improve safety conditions for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with added sidewalk and shared-use path, and provide an improved residential corridor.

Project Description

Project involves design for the reconstruction of the roadway; which includes a sidewalk, shared-use path, curb and gutter, and an enclosed storm sewer system along Summit Avenue from Alco Drive to Dooner Drive. The total project is estimated to cost \$555,000 and the City has been awarded \$363,836 in STP funding and has been granted \$77,959 in funding by Madison County. The expected cost to the City is estimated to be around \$113,205.

Existing Condition

The existing asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, and storm sewer system are in need of an upgrade and there are currently no sidewalks or shared-use paths along this portion of Summit Avenue.

Project Goals
