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**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Collinsville (hereinafter “the City”) recognizes the need to provide for the safety, health and welfare of Collinsville’s citizens and visitors by providing and regulating matters related to the service of water within and out of the corporate limits of the City;

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois state statutes contain several provisions that authorize municipalities to regulate the service of water within their jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the foregoing, the City is a home rule municipality under the Constitution and laws of the State of Illinois and by enacting this ordinance in the exercise of its home rule powers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Collinsville, in the County of Madison, and State of Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** The preamble paragraphs of this Ordinance shall be deemed included in this Section 1 as if set for verbatim herein.

**Section 2.** Title 13 (Public Services) of the Collinsville Code of Ordinances is hereby amended so as to read in its entirety as provided for in the attached Exhibit A entitled “Title 13 Public Services” which shall be deemed included in this Section 2 as if set forth verbatim herein.

**Section 3.** In the event any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, in whole or in part, such holding shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or any remaining part of this Ordinance, other than the part held unconstitutional or invalid.

**Section 4.** All ordinances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies.

**Section 5.** Nothing contained herein shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in any manner connected with the subject matter hereof, unless expressly set forth herein.

**Section 6.** This Ordinance is effective upon its passage by the City Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication according to law.
