SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of a resolution appropriating \$2,418,818.00 of Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) funds to pay for general maintenance and materials of City streets.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This resolution allows the City to utilize MFT funds to purchase materials and pay for labor and equipment for the general maintenance of City streets.

BACKGROUND

Illinois Highway Code requires the City to appropriate MFT funds prior to expending such funds. This resolution appropriates MFT funds for materials, labor, and equipment for the maintenance of City streets. The maintenance materials include salt for snow and ice control, concrete and asphalt for street repairs, concrete for curb and sidewalk repairs, oil and chips for resurfacing oil and chip streets, storm sewer pipes to fix roadway related drainage issues, and other necessary maintenance materials and activities.
