SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Approve ordinance authorizing the installation of a yield sign on Vivian Street at the intersection of Vivian Street and Rose Street.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The intersection of Vivian Street and Rose Street is an uncontrolled three-legged intersection. To reduce confusion of motorists and improve safety, staff recommends that a yield sign be installed on Vivian Street.

BACKGROUND

The intersection of Vivian Street is along the route to get to Summit Elementary School and Willoughby Farm. This intersection is a three-legged intersection; Rose Street serves as the east leg of the intersection; Vivian Street serves as the northern and southern legs of the intersection. Vivian Street is a two-way street on the northern leg of the intersection and is a southbound only street on the southern leg. Rose is a two-way street on the eastern leg of the intersection.

Traffic at this intersection primarily comes from Rose Street and proceeds southward through the intersection. To provide better direction on who has the right of way through the intersection, staff is recommending installing a stop sign Vivian Street at the intersection of Rose Street.
