SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the Ordinance designating motor vehicle speed limits on a portion of Horseshoe Lake Road.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Horseshoe Lake Road was recently reconstructed to support new development. As part of the engineering studies along this segment of road, it has been recommended to reduce the speed limit on Horseshoe Lake Road from 50-mph to 45-mph.

BACKGROUND

The properties north of Horseshoe Lake Road have started developing, which triggered the need to widen Horseshoe Lake Road, upgrade McDonough Lake Road, and improve the intersection of Horseshoe Lake Road and McDonough Lake Road.

As part of the planning and design process, it was recommended to reduce the speed along Horseshoe Lake Road to improve safety along Horseshoe Lake Road and at the intersection of Horseshoe Lake Road and McDonough Lake Road. The need to reduce the speed on Horseshoe Lake Road was determined based on safe stopping distance, distance between planned signalized intersection distance, and planned vehicular traffic.
