## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Firefighter/Paramedic Colin Fuhrmann recently received two awards from our EMS System hospital. Each award demonstrates Colin's dedication, exceptional patient care, mentorship, his efficiency and commitment to professional standards, mastery of skills, and leadership.

## **BACKGROUND**

The two awards are the Field Training Officer (FTO) of the year and the newly created Fearless, Outstanding, Resilient, Compassionate, and Exceptional (FORCE).
