## ORDINANCE NO.

## AMENDING THE COLLINSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 9, PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS AND WELFARE

(Adding Regulations Related to Merchants Duty to Keep Sidewalks Free of Litter)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLINSVILLE, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the Collinsville Municipal Code Title 9 (Public Peace, Morals and Welfare), Chapter 9.24 (Property Offenses), shall be amended by adding the following:

"Sec. 9.24.095. – Merchants Duty to keep sidewalks free of litter. Persons owning or occupying places of business shall keep the sidewalk in front of their business premises free of litter."

<u>SECTION 2</u>. If any part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any part thereof and said Ordinance shall be read as if said invalid provision was struck therefrom and the context thereof changed accordingly with the remainder of the Ordinance to be and remain in full force and effect.

**<u>SECTION 3</u>**. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication if necessary, as provided by law.
